Conversation Tree

Level: beginner, intermediate, advanced


<u>Goal</u>: to track participation in conversations, track how topics move, track appropriateness of communicative behavior and allows for visual reinforcement of reciprocal communication

<u>Materials needed</u>: these can be die cuts, cut outs from craft foam or scraps from the recycling bin, Conversation Topic cards (attached)

- treetop
- stump/tree bottom, squares for the trunk- each person gets their own color
- branches- can be a rectangle or use a pipe cleaners (place in a pile for all to use)
- Optional: just draw the shapes on a white/chalk board or on paper as you complete the activity

Activity:

- Each person gets a pile of colored squares. If you are drawing this just use a different colored marker for each student.
- The group is given a conversational topic or chooses their own.
- Each person who makes a relevant comment and then asks a question of another person can place his or her color square on the trunk and watch the tree grow.
- Add a branch to represent conversation/non-verbal errors. This marks a lack of trunk growth. This helps students to become more aware of what it takes to contribute to the conversation.
